While she shreds on electric guitar with her full band, her solo performances provide a much more intimate experience for the listener with her real stories, original songwriting and intricate guitar work.

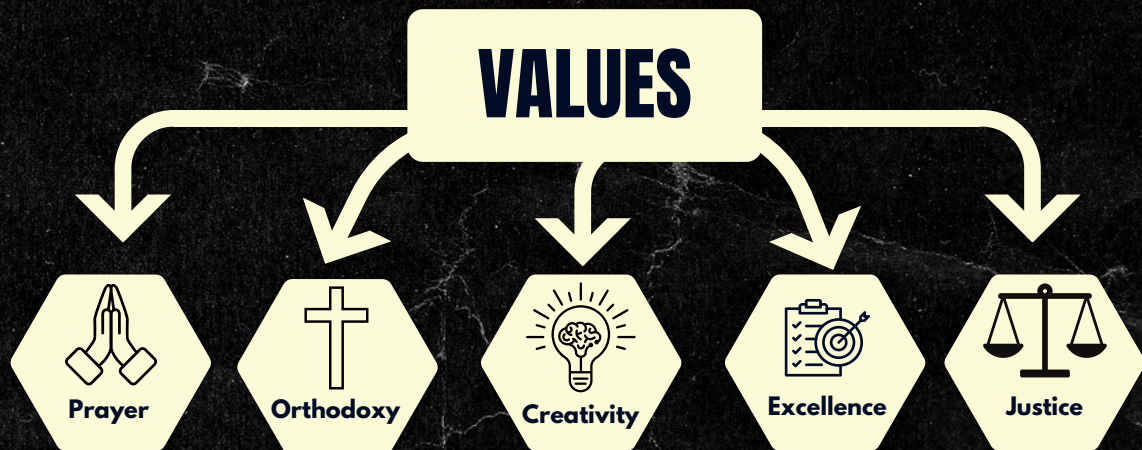
